









EXHIBITOR ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

-  Both shows are juried! Only fine art and fine craft of the highest quality will be accepted.
-  Both shows are for artists and craftspersons only! No applications will be accepted from dealers, traders, shops or representatives.
-  Applications are welcomed for any type of art or craft as long as it fits into an Indian-Southwest-Western-Wildlife or related theme. Some other types of booths such as Food, Authors, Musicians, etc. may also apply if they fit into the above mentioned theme.
-  All work exhibited in your booth must be original artwork created and hand produced by you the artist/craftsperson. Reproductions of your artwork are permitted if processed by you, or under your supervision. All work exhibited must be signed, priced and accurately described.
-  All artists-craftspersons must be present with their work. You are allowed to have agents and/or helpers assist you in selling your work, but it is important to the public coming to our event that they be able to meet you personally. Under some extreme circumstances this rule may be waived if approved by show management.



BOOTH SPACE AVAILABILITY

-  Both shows are held indoors..therefore space availability at each show is definitely limited.
-  We offer a variety of booth size choices to meet the needs of each exhibitor...but the smallest size we offer is a 10' x 10' space. We do understand that some exhibitors, with small items, etc. may find it hard to justify the cost of a 10' x 10' space or simply don't need that much space... therefore, shared spaces are acceptable.

APPLYING FOR THE SHOWS

-  The choice is yours...you may apply for only one or both shows. But each show will be juried by it's own specific needs and situation.
 - All applicants must submit 3 photos of your art or craft along with completed applications, or you can list on the application a web-site where your work can be viewed.
 - The photos need to be of good quality...remember that our jury will be making their selections from what they see in your photos.
 - If you are applying for more than one show...you need only send one set of photos.
 - Shared spaces...need only submit one application for each show, but must send 3 photos of each exhibitor's work.
 - Photo copies of application forms are acceptable, if properly completed and signed.

FIRST COME – FIRST SERVED 1ST JURY DATE: SEPTEMBER 15, 2009

-  There is no official deadline for receiving applications for our festivals. Spaces are assigned on a first come-first served basis.
-  On September 15, jury review will begin on all applications received prior to that date for each show. Should spaces still remain open after the first jury date, we will continue to accept applications until all spaces have been filled.



JURY SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION

- ✦ The main criteria for acceptance will be..quality and uniqueness of your work along with the category needs of our shows. Consideration will be given to exhibitors that displayed at our past shows..but will not serve as a guarantee of acceptance.
- ✦ For all applications received prior to September 15th..notices of acceptance, rejection or standby will be mailed by October 2nd.



BOOTH FEES

We try our best to keep booth fees as low as possible, but please keep in mind...you will be exhibiting at: a spectacular event...in a beautiful climate controlled building...with decorated exhibit area...among many of the top artists in the country...along with special attractions and fantastic entertainment...at a show that has been mega-advertised!

The bottom line is..."You cannot have Cadillac shows with Volkswagon booth fees!"

- ✦ We realize the difficulties exhibitors sometimes have in paying booth fees...especially several shows at one time! Therefore, in an effort to help out our exhibitors, we have adopted the following booth fee policies...
 - You may send 100% of your total booth fees due for the show...
 - Or you may send a deposit of 50% of your total booth fees due for each show that you are applying. **NOTICE** If you choose to pay by 50% deposit...the balances due for each show must be paid no later than 45 days prior to that show. If you fail to meet the deadline...your deposit will be forfeited and your space will be resold to the next person on our waiting list!!
- ✦ Applicants must submit a separate check for each show that you are applying...Upon acceptance to a show, your check for that show will be deposited. Rejected applicant checks will be returned with notice of rejection. Standby applicant checks will be held and only deposited should an opening arise.



CANCELLATION POLICY

Submission of an application is a commitment to participate in the show. Upon acceptance and notice of acceptance, your booth fees or deposits become non-refundable. Should you need to cancel a show for any reason...there will be no refund!!!



TO APPLY

- You must send a completed application form for each show that you are applying for.
- Only one set of photos are necessary to cover all shows that you are applying for.
- You must send a separate check for each show which you are applying to.
- Your check or checks must be at least 50% of your total booth fees due for each show.
- ✦ All applicants must submit the following:
 1. Three photos representative of your work to be displayed, or list your web-site.
 2. Completed applications for each show you are applying for.
 3. Appropriate booth fees or deposits (a separate check for each show).
 4. A self-addressed, stamped envelope.
